Project: We will be looking at artist Bridget Riley and Op Art. Op Art is just that optical illusions made through drawing, design, and color.

Process: First I graphed out my design, I did a basic reducing line graph from left and right to the center, and top and bottom to the center, where the line widths got smaller as they neared the center of the page. Then I began to color every other box - checkerboard style. When coloring I started on the left with black and used lighter shades of grey as I approached the center, I repeated the same shades on the right. As you see the picture almost feels like it is moving. Many people even got motion sick when viewing Bridgette's work.

Materials: This project will require paper, a ruler, a pencil, and markers, Black, Dark grey, medium-dark grey, grey, and light grey. If you don't have markers you can make your own gradient paint with black and white.
